"CAN WE STILL HEAR THE LORD'S LOW WHISPER?"

Elijah was having a pity party. The most powerful prophet of Scripture is found in a deep, dark cave. Let me remind you that Elijah had just confronted the 450 prophets of Baal and the 400 prophets of Asherah. He sets up two altars. Both have the stones, the wood, and the bulls—but no fire. The 850 prophets of the false gods try to get their gods to send fire by screaming, dancing, and cutting themselves. Of course, no fire was sent. Then, Elijah prays to the one true God and "his" God (our God) sent fire that consumed not only the sacrifice, but burned the wood and stones and the water that Elijah poured over the altar and even the dust around the altar (I Kings 18:19-40).

Elijah should be so full of faith that nothing could shake him; but Elijah is all too human—just like us. He hears that Queen Jezebel has vowed to kill him, and in fear, he flees to

the deep dark cave of pity. He cried out to the Lord in desperation. God commanded him to get out of the cave and go on the mountain. He obeyed. Suddenly, there is a strong wind; but the Lord was not in the wind. Then, there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. Then, there is a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. Then, there was a low whisper (I Kings 19:12). *That* is where Elijah found his Lord and found his faith back.

I am writing this article on September 11. It has been 16 years since that horrific attack on our country. It has been only two weeks since Hurricane Harvey hit Texas and only hours after Hurricane Irma caused devastation in Florida and in the Caribbean. Four days ago, an 8.1 level earthquake struck just miles from Chiapas, Mexico—where many of us went to build mission

buildings. And some of the worst fires that the West and Canada have seen are still burning.

Right now our world (our continent) needs to hear and see the voice of God in thousands of low whispers. The world needs to see Christians silently giving money to bring relief. It needs to see Christians praying, caring, and helping pick up the pieces. People need to be helped and held and encouraged and loved. All of it needs to be done in the name of our Lord and God.

Will people be angry and blame God? Sure! But, when they see and feel the low whisper of Christians caring and giving and rebuilding with them, they can't help also hearing the whisper of the voice of God saying; "I still love you. My followers will prove it to you."

CIVIC THEATRE PLAY: "ANNIE"



WHAT'S HAPPENING IN MALAWI?

Dear Fellowship Family,

Last year, There is Hope expanded its scholarship program from the university level to include vulnerable girls in the secondary level. It's a common theme for these girls to find themselves dropping out of school because their families can no longer pay their school fees. When that happens, it is also very common for these girls to find themselves married and prematurely becoming mothers. Currently in Malawi, only 46% of school-aged girls actually find themselves in school. There is Hope felt a need to assist these young ladies to help them complete their education.

In 2016, There is Hope sent three young ladies to school. This year we selected a different school and sent seven young ladies. Their first day of school was September 18, and April will be checking in with them on a regular basis to monitor their progress. This is an exciting time in these girls' lives, but they will face plenty of challenges. Please pray for these girls—that they will excel in their studies this year. Pray that the challenges they face will remain small, and that they feel the love and support of not only There is Hope, but their sponsors and prayer warriors as well. Thank you once again as a church and individuals for your faithful support as we serve in Malawi.


